**The Breed Survey** is open to dogs of 18 months and older on the day of the survey.

**CLASS 1A Survey** - A total Hip Score of 20 and under is required.

**CLASS 1B Survey** - A male requires a total Hip Score of 25 and under.  
A female requires a total Hip Score of 30 and under.

**CLASS 1B Survey** - If a dog or bitch is a maximum of 2.5cm over or under the correct height.

## **FURTHER RULES FOR BREED SURVEYS**

---

### **CLASS 1.A**

1. Flawless bite, complete dentures, no large gaps.
2. Double P1 s and a missing or broken tooth accompanied by an official vet's letter.
3. Minimum grading " Very Good"
4. Hip Score Total 20.
5. LONGCOATS. The top coat should be long, straight and lying tightly. It should not be soft and an undercoat must be present.

### **CLASS 1.B**

1. Missing 1 x P1
2. Males Hip score Total 25
3. Females Hip Score Total 30
4. A level bite

### **DISQUALIFYING FACTORS**

*The absence of:*

1. One Canine
2. One P3 or 4 or a Molar
3. A total of any 2 teeth.  
(Unless a vet's letter provided)
4. An overshot mouth by the thickness of a match stick or more.
5. An under shot mouth.
6. Tooth decay or unhealthy gums.
7. Worn down and discoloured.  
(If due to age no major downgrading if tooth substance is good.)
8. LONG COATS. Top coat soft and open with no undercoat present.

### **THE COURAGE TEST**

The dog will be threatened by the helper and is required to bite and hold the sleeve. After a short "fight" the sleeve will be given to the dog and the helper will move away.

The handler then takes the dog into a crowd, which will include the helper, and the dog is required to walk calmly in and out of the crowd – as directed by the surveyor.
