This form is for use by the <b>owner(s)</b> (<i>Not breeder(s)</i>) to register a <b>single dog</b> over the age of three(3) calendar months at the date of application</li> <li>2. Full details must be provided herein, and this application must be accompanied by a letter of no objection from the relevant breed club.</li> <li>3. Applications in the name of <b>joint owners</b> must bear the signature of <b>all</b> such joint owners.</li> <li>4. In the case of a <b>scheduled breed</b> this application must be accompanied by the requisite <b>veterinary certificate</b> on the appropriate EAKC Form.</li> <li>5. Throughout this form the following abbreviations and alternatives will be found or are acceptable:<br/> D = Dog / Male                      B = Bitch / Female<br/> Sire = Father                          Dam = Mother</li> <li>6. Where boxes have been provided for names etc. only one letter, space or punctuation mark shall be placed in each box. The given number of boxes (24) may not be exceeded.</li> <li>7. Any person applying for a registration is deemed to be bound by the EAKC Rules and Regulations in all canine matters.</li> <li>8. Only Class 1 Registered dogs are eligible for issue of Export Pedigrees.</li> <li>9. A dog's name is selected by the person registering the dog.</li> <li>10. A name must consist of more than one word, but no name including the Affix shall exceed 24 letters, each space, hyphen full-stop or apostrophe is to be counted as a letter.</li> </ol> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>11. The following are not acceptable for inclusion in names: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Names of notable persons</li> <li>• Numbers in figures or words if indicating a sequence.</li> <li>• A single-letter word to begin a name</li> <li>• The registree's surname</li> <li>• Canine terms, e.g. dog, bitch, champion, Crufts, kennel, breed names or breed abbreviations such as Doby.</li> <li>• Words or names which might offend.</li> <li>• Proper or geographical names where these are part of the breed name e.g. German or Germany for G.S.D.</li> <li>• Words from a dog's pedigree which may be affixes held by another person.</li> </ul> </li> <li>12. An alternative name must be submitted in addition to the one desired, except in case of dogs registered only for Obedience, Agility or Working Trials.</li> <li>13. A name once registered cannot be registered in the same breed for 15 years after 1<sup>st</sup> January following the last registration.</li> <li>14. The Council reserves the right to refuse to register any name which it regards as inappropriate.</li> </ol> |
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
